EXHIBITORS AND VENDORS

Earth Day is the unifying theme of the Lullaby of the Rivers Festival. Interactive exhibitions and vendors as well as some of Florida's finest musicians make this festival attractive to all ages, while at the same time serving an important purpose — to raise awareness of environmental issues and educate children about the natural world so that they will grow up wanting to protect it.

EARTH DAY FAIR EXHIBITORS

Organizations are welcome to set up a free booth in the Earth Day Fair. Exhibitors at the fair provide activities for kids and adults and educational exhibits that teach about nature. Share your passion, whether it be turtles, manatees, earthworms, owls, composting, stargazing or some other aspect of nature. We believe that connecting with nature will inspire people to preserve and protect our natural resources, habitat and environment.

VENDORS

The sky's the limit on the kinds of things vendors can offer. We expect there will be handmade items, recycled items, and all sorts of items with a nature theme. Wellness is a huge bonus of connecting with nature, so we encourage vendors offering goods or services that contribute naturally to health and wellbeing. We really hope there will be a book vendor, because there are so many wonderful books for all ages about nature and experiences in the out-of-doors.

THINGS TO KNOW FOR EXHIBITORS AND VENDORS

- Exhibitor fee: freeVendor fee: \$35/day
- Tasting Tent Vendor fee: \$25/table
- Setup begins an hour prior to festival opening.
- Vehicles are not allowed on the field during festival hours.
- Provide your own tables, chairs and tents.
- Tasting Tent vendors will be under a tent, but provide their own tables.
- There is no electricity.
- Noise must be kept to a minimum.
- Political campaigning is not allowed.
- Dogs are permitted only in the dog park.

The Tasting Tent Vendor Information

This new attraction takes place on Sunday, April 23 from noon to 5pm. Admission to the Tasting Tent is included for all ticket holders.

Vendors at the Tasting Tent demonstrate a commitment to Earth Day values, such as organic/non-GMO products, sustainable agriculture, recycling, composting, reusing materials. Vendors are assigned space under a large tent where they offer a taste of their products to festival attendees visiting the tent. A "taste" can consist of a cube of cheese, a slice of sausage, a wedge of melon, an ounce or two of beverage in a disposable cup, or similar servings. In addition to offering a taste, they may sell products.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR TASTING TENT VENDORS

- Vendors provide coolers/ice if products needs to be kept chilled.
- Strict limitations on use of styrofoam and other adverse products.
